Sprouts Farmers Market is planning to open a Location in West Arvada

In the summer of 2015, Cadence Capital Investments, a Colorado development firm, and Sprouts Farmers Market, a national grocer with 240 stores in 13 states, worked together to find a good place to call home in West Arvada.
